Minutes of the IQAC Meeting held on 19.12.2020

According to the resolutions of the Online meeting of the IQAC members, Students Exhibition Committee 2020, faculties conducted via Google Meet, the following is being notified to all concerned.

1. The Exhibition Committee proposes that a new date should be considered for submission of new works. A minimum of two weeks (14 days) from now should be given to all students to complete a new work for submission. However, this new submission must not be compulsory for all.
2. New date of submission will be intimated to students through a separate notice. A centralized, department wise submission link will be sent to students (using GOOGLE forms) to streamline the data collection and selection process. This will help us in data uniformity. Submission links will be made available by the coordination committee to the Jury, for final selection of art works. Students may submit maximum of one new work for selection, however department selection committee may choose to select/consider old works submitted on or before 17th December 2020, following the earlier notice.
3. The tentative college exhibition budget and other funding options should be immediately discussed to start the process. According to the allotted budget, virtual exhibition platforms will be purchased. This time the required amount need to be paid in advance and in full, otherwise the online virtual exhibition platforms cannot be purchased from the service providers.
4. Tentative Date of the commencement of Actual Online Exhibition will be notified to all after submission of all works and procurement of required platform.
5. A faculty representative from each specialization should be nominated by the In-charge(s), who will communicate with the coordination committee regarding all matters concerning the respective departments. The Representative's name should be submitted to the undersigned by 21.12.2020.
6. A separate category for watercolour and photography could be kept where all interested students can submit their works for selection. An extremely limited number of outstanding works will be finally selected by selection committee and showcased in the virtual exhibition. The actual number will be decided by the coordination committee and will be informed to the selection committee.

7. The specific list of awards/merits should be provided to the selection and coordination committee.

Prescribed forms and other information for admission to M.F.A for the session 2021-2022 will be available through college website from the 5 th of September 2021 to 18th of September 2021. One may download and upload the forms through college website www.gcac.edu.in. All applicants are requested to go through all the instructions, procedures and norms as given in the website before filling the admission forms.

Eligibility For M.F.A

- i) Candidate must have Qualified BFA/BVA or equivalent Exam. Candidates who have secured 55% Marks and above are eligible to apply.
- ii) Applicants for 'Print Making' may have qualified BFA/BVA with any one of the following subjects: **a.Painting, b.Painting Indian Style, c.Graphic Design/Applied Art** apart from **Printmaking** itself. For candidates applying for all other specializations, they must have qualified BFA/BVA with the same specialization they are applying for.
- iii) Applicants who have passed from Other Universities (Other than University of Calcutta) must produce equivalence certificate from Calcutta University as & when required.
- iv) Six (6 nos.) art works executed by the candidate duly attested by the last attended College/University authority (if possible) to be submitted in scanned format in A4 size each in a single PDF not exceeding 10 MB size.

Copy of Documents required at the time of uploading the application form:

- Mark sheet of BFA/BVA Examination or equivalent.
- Admit Card of Madhyamik Examination or equivalent / Admit Card/ registration Certificate issued from recognized Board / Council (for age Proof).
- SC/ ST/OBC/PWD certificate if any.
- Aadhar Card
- Passport (in case of foreign Nationals)
- Photo & Scanned copy of signature. Reservation: Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidate will be as per rules of the Govt. of West Bengal.
